Getting started with Kindle eReaders

You can borrow Kindle Books from your library and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle eReader.

If you're using a Kindle Fire, Fire HD, or Fire HDX, please refer to our guide on <u>getting started with Kindle Fire tablets</u>.

Note: Kindle Books are currently available for U.S. libraries only.

Step 1

Use a computer or mobile device to open your library's digital collection (find it using www.overdrive.com).

Step 2

In your library's digital collection, use the <u>advanced search</u> or search filters to <u>find and borrow an</u> <u>eBook that's available in the **Kindle Book** format.</u>

Step 3

Select to go to your **Loans** page. From there, select **Download**, then **Kindle Book**.

You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

Step 4

On Amazon's website, <u>follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle eReader</u>. You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.

Note: Your Kindle eReader must have a Wi-Fi internet connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you will need to <u>transfer the Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader via USB.</u>

Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader, it works like any other Kindle Book.
