

# Getting started with Kindle eReaders

You can borrow Kindle Books from your library and deliver them wirelessly to your Kindle eReader.

If you're using a Kindle Fire, Fire HD, or Fire HDX, please refer to our guide on [getting started with Kindle Fire tablets](#).

**Note:** *Kindle Books are currently available for U.S. libraries only.*

## Step 1

Use a computer or mobile device to open your library's digital collection (find it using [www.overdrive.com](http://www.overdrive.com)).

## Step 2

In your library's digital collection, use the [advanced search](#) or search filters to [find and borrow an eBook that's available in the Kindle Book format](#).

## Step 3

Select  to go to your **Loans** page. From there, select **Download**, then **Kindle Book**.

You'll be taken to Amazon's website to complete your checkout.

## Step 4

On Amazon's website, [follow the on-screen prompts to "Get library book" and wirelessly deliver it to your Kindle eReader](#). You'll need to sign into (or create) an Amazon account to complete this process.

**Note:** *Your Kindle eReader must have a Wi-Fi internet connection to download library Kindle Books from Amazon. If you don't have a Wi-Fi connection, you will need to [transfer the Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader via USB](#).*

Once you deliver a library Kindle Book to your Kindle eReader, it [works like any other Kindle Book](#).
